

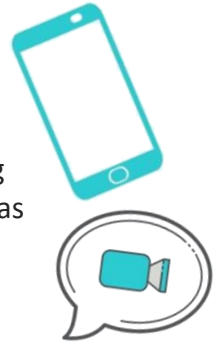


BIG IDEAS WEEKLY

PLAY A CLASSIC GAME TOGETHER

1. WOULD YOU RATHER

This game is extremely fun to play especially if you are just starting to get to know a person or a group. Would You Rather is a simple game where the players have to choose between two answers. For example, a player will be asked “Would you rather play Chess or Mahjong?” and they have to choose between Mahjong and Chess.

2. ANTAKSHARI

This is a popular game played by South Asians and the rules are pretty straightforward. The first player has to sing a song and stop at a particular word. The next player has to sing a song that starts with the letter that the previous player ended with.


3. 20 QUESTIONS

It's a classic group game but it is also one of the best games to play over FaceTime. One player gets to choose a word while the rest have to ask a set of 20 questions to determine that word. The questions can only be answered with a “yes” or a “no” so choose the questions wisely!
