Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) are forms of **trauma**, including **abuse, neglect or household dysfunction**, that often lead to long-term toxic stress and/or mental illness.

OUR FOCUS: YOUTH IN MARGINALIZED COMMUNITIES WITH GREATER ACEs

Abuse, neglect, absent parent, mental health, high-risk behaviour, socio-economic barriers, victimization, neglect, witnessing violence, bullying.

MENTORING, AN INTERVENTION

Research demonstrates that the best ways to help eliminate long-term consequences of ACEs is through Developmental Relationships (*stable and committed relationship with a supportive parent, caregiver, or other adult*).

This confirms how important the work of Big Brothers Big Sisters is. Our work does not eliminate ACEs in a young person's life, however, mentorship helps to mitigate the long-term negative effects of ACEs.
